- ◆ Singapore is a multi-ethnic nation (70% Chinese, 12% Malay, 9% Indian, 9% Other) and its official languages are English, Chinese, Malay and Tamil. For this reason, the Counsellor reiterated the importance of English for communication among different ethnic groups.
